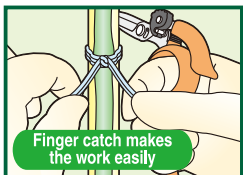

No.RB-5 (Diameter 5mm)

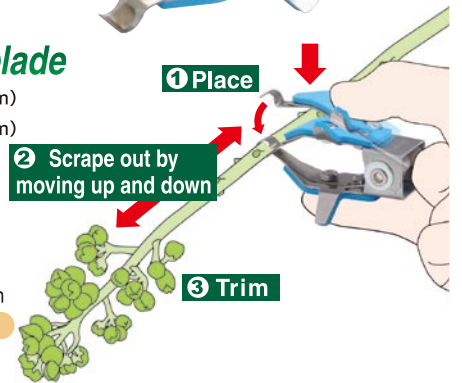
No.RB-7 (Diameter 7mm)
